From the Pastor's Desk -

Friends, the past couple weeks have been a trying time in the life of our church and in our own personal lives. Just looking out the window, hearing the Spring song birds chirping, seeing the sunlight lasting later into our evenings, watching cars drive by albeit a bit less frequently than normal, we can get lulled back into a sense of normalcy, which sounds very good about now. Yet all we need do is turn on the radio or the television or look to our phones and we are inundated by the news of this awful virus. A virus that has closed schools nationwide, sent many workers home, and even closed our public worship forcing us to learn new ways of gathering as God's people online or on our own.

I'm going to put this next sentence in bold so even the skimmers will see it. In consultation with Aron and David, we have decided to follow the advice of Governor Whitmer and NOT hold public worship until after April 12 which means we will not have public worship services for Holy Week. On the one hand, it seems impossible to not have our traditions that week: waving Palm branches, remembering the Last Supper, experiencing the loss of Jesus to crucifixion, and then celebrating the resurrection with a communal breakfast, egg hunt for our children, invigorating worship with the sanctuary filled with song, people, and flowers. We will still celebrate the good news of the resurrection this year, but we will do so in our own homes, much like the early Christians did.

But there are still ways for us to be together. Palm branches ordered far before the virus hit, arrived this week. Palm branches may be picked up at the door in the back parking lot near the sanctuary entrance on Saturday, April 4 from 10am to noon. We will offer online worship for Maundy Thursday and Good Friday both at 7pm, and again for Easter worship on April 12. For Easter morning worship, we will try something new once again: online communion. If you can have ready some bread and some juice, we will be able to commune together even though we are not in the same room.

These are difficult times, but this is not the first time our world has faced a global pandemic. Let us continue to do as we have been instructed: wash your hands, keep a good distance between people, no handshaking, stay home and stay safe. Easter is coming whether we worship together or online. The good news of the resurrection will not be stopped. Thanks be to God.

HAND2HAND: Life has really changed and become more challenging these past few weeks. We at H2H are taking measures to ensure the safety of our volunteers and the children we serve while we still provide weekend food so our kids don't go hungry. Each Thursday, H2H volunteers from ALL the programs at ALL the schools in Hudsonville come to our parking lot with their backpack food. Families in the various programs come here to receive their food. Person to person contact is minimal as our volunteer hands a bag of food to our regional director who takes the food to the family in their car. Plans are to provide this help for 3 weeks beginning last week March 19. Future distributions may be planned as the changing situation dictates. I have been told we have enough food in our pantry (thanks to your generosity) to last until the end of the regular school year, A REALLY BIG THANK YOU to Pat Hall, Pat Vieau, Kevin Boggs, and his friend who have been our volunteers. H2H has requested no volunteers 65 or older to pass out food. We may need a couple of our younger congregation to help in future distributions.
